Tulalip Tribe Grants Innovative Services NW \$3,000 for Early Learning Expansion Project

VANCOUVER, WA—The Tulalip Tribe has granted Innovative Services NW \$3,000 to aid in the Early Learning Expansion Project.

Innovative Services NW Early Learning Program serves approximately 128 children and their families per year in Clark County and surrounding areas. Over 400 meals are prepared weekly in the Helping Hands kitchen.

The Expansion Project is slated to begin in May 2022 and will add an additional classroom to the current eight classrooms and increase kitchen capacity. The expansion will serve the growing needs of families seeking quality early childhood education services in Clark County.

The Early Learning program at Innovative Services NW includes the Early Childhood Education and Assistance Program (ECEAP) which offers free preschool for income-eligible children with risk factors such as family violence, homelessness, chemical dependency, CPS involvement, incarcerated parents, disabilities or foster care. ECEAP also includes family support and parent's involvement, child health coordination and nutrition and other services responsive to each child's family heritage and experience.
