Innovative Services NW Early Learning Program Set to Graduate 56 Children

VANCOUVER, WA—Innovative Services NW Early Learning Program is set to graduate 56 children at the end of August 2021.

The Early Learning program provides early learning education to children ages 12 months to four years old and has seven classrooms—five of which are dedicated to the Early Childhood Education and Assistance Program (ECEAP).

The Early Childhood Education and Assistance Program (ECEAP) offers free preschool for income-eligible children or those with risk factors such as family violence, homelessness, chemical dependency, CPS involvement, incarcerated parents, disabilities or foster care. ECEAP also includes family support and parent involvement, child health coordination and nutrition and other services responsive to each child's family heritage and experience.

A notable partner in supporting the graduating children is the Assistance League of Southwest Washington. They have provided all 56 children with a backpack, school supplies and a book for the upcoming school year.

All 56 graduating children will attend kindergarten around Clark County and surrounding areas beginning in the Fall. The Early Learning staff is honored to have been a part of their preschool experience and look forward to hearing about their kindergarten experience.
